**ADMONISHMENT FOR MINOR MISCONDUCT**

Tarica C. LaBossiere, the Supreme Court of Florida has approved an Admonishment for Minor Misconduct for your actions in this case.

In August 2018, you pled guilty to one count of Driving Under the Influence (enhanced), a misdemeanor. In March 2019, the grievance committee considered this matter and made a diversion recommendation that required you to enter into a contract with Florida Lawyers Assistance, Inc. (FLA, Inc.). You initially accepted this recommendation, but you failed to comply with the conditions of the FLA, Inc. contract and the matter was returned to the grievance committee. By engaging in said conduct you violated R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-4.3.


Tarica C. LaBossiere, your misconduct in this matter, while found to be minor, is nevertheless a violation of the Rules Regulating The Florida
