**ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on a case management conference on August 21, 2020, counsel for the parties having appeared telephonically; and the court being otherwise fully advised in the premises FINDS:

1. Attorney Tyler Trumbach appeared on behalf of respondent, on a limited basis, for the 8/18/20 and 8/21/20 hearings only.
2. Counsel reported the status of the parties.
3. During the motion hearing held on 8/18/20, the Court granted respondent's motion to propound 10 additional requests for admission (including sub-parts).
4. Respondent requested a continuance of the final hearing due to personal health issues and her intent to hire an attorney to represent her in this matter.

5. Court restrictions on in-person hearings remain in place and Florida Supreme Court AO20-23 provides that whenever practicable, all nonessential hearings shall be conducted via electronic means.

6. The Florida Bar intends to file an objection to respondent's recently served discovery.

Therefore, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

1. The Florida Bar, on behalf of the Referee, will file a Motion for Extension of Time to File the Report of Referee for 45 days or until November 23, 2020.

2. If the foregoing motion is granted, this matter will be set for a case management conference to reschedule the final hearing. If the motion is not granted, this matter will proceed to final hearing on September 16-17, 2020 as scheduled.


3. The final hearing will be conducted by Zoom.

4. In accordance with Rule 3-7.6(h)(4), absent extraordinary circumstances, no further motions will be heard before the final hearing except for the bar's objection to respondent's current discovery.

5. If Attorney Trumbach wishes to withdraw from this matter he shall obtain an order granting withdrawal concluding his representation of respondent.
