This is before the Court on The Florida Bar's Petition for Contempt and Order to Show Cause.

The Court having issued its Order to Show Cause to respondent and respondent having failed to file a response to said Order to Show Cause,

IT IS ORDERED that The Florida Bar's petition is granted and Respondent Richard Luther Bradford is held in contempt of this Court's order, dated November 2, 2017, in Case No. SC17-1781, and this Court's order dated May 3, 2018, in Case No. SC17-1638. As a sanction, respondent is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Respondent is currently suspended; therefore this suspension is effective immediately. Respondent shall fully comply with Rule Regulating the Florida Bar 3-5.1(h). Respondent shall also comply with the terms of the Court's orders in SC17-1781 and SC17-1638, prior to petitioning for reinstatement.

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
