Upon consideration of the report of referee and briefs filed in this case, the Court hereby approves the referee's findings of fact and recommendation as to guilt. However, the Court disapproves the recommended sanction of a public reprimand, and instead respondent is suspended from the practice of law for sixty days, effective thirty days from the date of this order so that respondent can close out his practice and protect the interests of existing clients. If respondent notifies this Court in writing that he is no longer practicing and does not need the thirty days to protect existing clients, this Court will enter an order making the suspension effective immediately. Respondent shall fully comply with Rule Regulating the Florida Bar 3-5.1(h). In addition, respondent shall accept no new business from the date this order is filed until he is reinstated. Respondent is further directed to comply with all other terms and conditions of the report.

Respondent is directed to attend The Florida Bar's Ethics School under the terms and conditions set forth in the report.

Upon reinstatement, respondent is further placed on probation for one year under the terms and conditions set forth in the report.

Judgment is entered for The Florida Bar, 651 East Jefferson Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2300, for recovery of costs from Charles Alexander Greene, Jr., in the amount of \$3,953.71, for which sum let execution issue.

Not final until time expires to file motion for rehearing, and if filed, determined. The filing of a motion for rehearing shall not alter the effective date of this suspension.
